

Internship International Projects

[Wintertuin](#) is a literary organisation based in Nijmegen that organises festivals, literary programming and workshops revolving around the theme of fiction as our guide. We also offer emerging writers a space for experiment and a platform for exchange. We coach them in the development of an autonomous professional practice.

In our international project [CELA](#), Connecting Emerging Literary Artists, we offer writers, translators and literary professionals a space for exchange and collaboration across borders and language barriers.

Wintertuin has an online literary magazine: [De Notulen van het Onzichtbare](#). And we publish chapbooks and other books.

Wintertuin is offering a research internship (x/f/m) to support the international project of Wintertuin (CELA), and to investigate the possibilities of joining the international residency programme [ICORN](#).

Our interns are an integral part of our organisation. They are involved in numerous projects and are expected to support our organisation practically as well as artistically. They join our weekly staff meetings and we work alongside them as colleagues.

The work consists of meetings, brainstorming sessions, writing e-mails, googling, reading, but also of leaving your desk to talk to target groups and partners, and of assisting us during events.

Our interns do this under close supervision of our employees, who sit with them every two weeks to make sure the internship is working for the both of us and you feel comfortable with our organisation.

What do we offer?

- Period: September 2022-January 2023.
- Time: 2-4 days a week.
- Language: the internship can be either in English or in Dutch.
- Assignment: You will be involved in supporting the project coordinator of CELA in implementing the activities of the project, talking to the partners across Europe, supporting them in any way possible. Also, you will be involved in making the first steps towards a next application with the Creative Europe Programme of the EU.
- Furthermore, you will dive into the who, what, where of the ICORN project, investigating the possibilities of a new international project for Wintertuin, also under supervision of the project coordinator. Your goal is to write a recommendation of what is needed and possible for Wintertuin to take the next steps in joining the ICORN network.
- Payment: 150 euro per month, based on a 3-day internship (the fee includes possible travel costs from home to office).

We will decide on the duration, days and starting moment of the internship in close collaboration. Please send your application, consisting of a motivation (this can be in any form: a letter, a video, something different) and an up-to-date resumé to info@wintertuin.nl.

We are looking forward to **receiving your application June 20 at the latest**.

Selection (based on meetings) will take place in the first week of July.
